The Great Miracle of the Sun of Fatima: For the last five months the Parish has been celebrating the Centenary of the Fatima (Portugal) Apparitions to the three children, Lucia, Jacinta & Francesco. **On next Friday evening (October 13th), we conclude our celebrations with a Special Mass at 7.30pm in the Parish Church, followed by Candlelight Rosary Procession and Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament.** The final of the six apparitions of Our Lady of the Rosary (for this is how She named Herself) was accompanied by a Miracle of the Sun witnessed by 70,000 people. This Miracle had been promised by the children's Vision three months in advance. Many believed and many doubted the Visions of the children, but after the October 13th Miracle of the Sun, no one doubted the children anymore. The following is an eyewitness account from Science Professor Dr. Almeida Garrett: "The most astonishing thing was to be able to stare at the solar disc for a long time, brilliant with light and heat, without hurting the eyes or damaging the retina. [During this time], the sun's disc did not remain immobile, it had a giddy motion, [but] not like the twinkling of a star in all its brilliance for it spun round upon itself in a mad whirl. During the solar phenomenon, which I have just described, there were also changes of colour in the atmosphere. Looking at the sun, I noticed that everything was becoming darkened. I looked first at the nearest objects and then extended my glance further afield as far as the horizon. I saw everything had assumed an amethyst colour. Objects around me, the sky and the atmosphere, were of the same colour. Everything both near and far had changed, taking on the colour of old yellow damask. People looked as if they were suffering from jaundice and I recall a sensation of amusement at seeing them look so ugly and unattractive. My own hand was the same colour. Then, suddenly, one heard a clamour, a cry of anguish breaking from all the people. The sun, whirling wildly, seemed all at once to loosen itself from the firmament and, blood red, advance threateningly upon the earth as if to crush us with its huge and fiery weight. The sensation during those moments was truly terrible".

Prior to the Miracle Our Lady asked, as she had done in previous months for people to pray the Rosary every day. She concluded Her message by saying: **"Do not offend God, Our Lord anymore, for He is already too much offended."** May Our Lady and the little children of Fatima pray for us.

Safe Talk – Suicide prevention talk: Safe Talk is an evening's training programme that prepares participants to identify persons with thoughts of suicide and connect them to suicide first aid resources. These specific skills are called suicide alertness and are taught with the expectation that the person learning them will use them to help reduce suicide risk in their communities. The Safe Talk takes place on **Tuesday October 10th, 7 – 10pm.** Whilst this training is suitable for everyone who wants to help prevent suicide and is prepared to become suicide alert, it is not suited to someone who may be recently bereaved by suicide. The training is provided free by the HSE.
