A Light In Darkness: Black famine ravaged the West of Ireland and Mayo in particular in 1879. The poor simple people had long been crushed by penal laws, religious persecution, rack rents and landlord evictions. It was Ireland’s darkest night, Ireland’s troubled hour. Yet the people kept faith, never failing in their love for the Mass and the Rosary. It was in this dark hour that 15 official witnesses declared that they saw an incredible Vision at the gable end of their Church at Knock, on August 21st, 1879. The Vision composed of Our Lady with a Queen’s Crown in a posture of contemplation. To her right in a posture of bowed veneration was the figure of St. Joseph and to her left, that of St. John the Apostle, dressed as a Bishop with the book of the Gospels, preaching. Further to Our Lady’s left was a young Lamb standing on an Altar facing west, behind the Lamb was a plain Cross surrounded by Angels. The first to witness anything unusual that evening was the 15 year old sister of the Sacristan Margaret Byrne, who had gone to lock the Church. She noticed an unusual brightness all around the Church, it was 8.30pm in the evening. It was two older women while passing the Church first realised the Vision and then a number of others gathered and witnessed it. The witnesses were fifteen in number and of all ages, the youngest was six years old, John Curry. The Vision lasted two hours, one shed tears during it, others prayed the Rosary. It was pouring rain during it, they were all wet, while the figures were dry. God had sent His Mother to Knock to console, to strengthen and to give hope to a crushed people.

The Novena to Our Lady of Knock begins on Monday August 14th and concludes on Tuesday August 22nd. Some copies of the Novena are available today at Church doors.
