### **Catechesis of the Good Shepherd - New Way of Presenting Faith to children**

This is an innovative approach to the religious formation of children both spiritually and educationally. It is grounded in sacred scripture, the liturgy of the Church and the spiritual and educational principles of Dr. Marie Montessori. It respects the relationship between God and the child and nourishes that relationship. Using concrete materials (such as 3D figures) the children are introduced to a biblical text or a liturgical moment. The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd allows children to experience and know Jesus and the faith we profess at a deeper level.

As of **November 9th, 2012 and every Friday during the school terms**, the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd will take place in the **Town Hall** at the following times: Preschool (3-4yrs old) - 1.15pm to 2.00pm  
Junior and Senior infants (5-6yr olds) - 2.00pm to 3.00pm  
First and Second Class (7-8yr olds) - 3.00pm to 4.00pm

## CHRISTMAS SHOE BOX APPEAL - TEAM HOPE

Team Hope are once more asking your help in bringing some Christmas joy to the poorest children in our world. There are children in the poorest countries of our world who have never experienced the joy of receiving a Christmas present, many of these children are orphans whose parents were killed in war or who died from illness.

You can help these children by filling a shoe box with practical items i.e. something to WRITE with (pen, copybook, markers, crayons etc), something to WASH with (toothbrush, toothpaste, facecloth, soap), something to WEAR (hat, scarf, gloves, socks) and WOW a treat or a toy (sunglasses, skipping rope, small doll or cuddly toy, a toy car). In 2012 over 172,000 shoeboxes from Ireland were sent to children in the poorest countries with over 2,500 of these shoeboxes coming from the Mitchelstown / Fermoy / West Waterford area. These locally collected shoeboxes were sent to Odessa in the Ukraine and were delivered in time for Christmas.
