Cobh Cathedral - Centenary Celebration: On Sunday August 25th next the Diocese of Cloyne will mark the Centenary of the Consecration of St. Colman's Cathedral, Cobh, with the celebration of the Eucharist at 3pm. The Diocese will also celebrate the completion of the recent restoration work with the internal cleaning and the refurbishment of the Telford Organ. Bishop Crean wishes to acknowledge that all the work of restoration, initiated by Bishop Magee, has been made possible by the generosity of the people of the Diocese. Therefore, the celebration on Sunday, August 25th is an event for the whole Diocese. So that every Parish of the Diocese can be represented, an allocation of tickets has been given to each Parish. Mitchelstown has received 24 tickets. If any Parishioner would like to attend, you are asked to give your name and telephone number in the Sacristy today after Mass. The building of the famous Cobh Cathedral began under Bishop Keane in 1869 and took 50 years to complete. The Consecration took place in August 1919. The Bishop at the time was Dr. Browne. The Cathedral is outstanding for its artistic beauty, inside and outside. Its site and location, overlooking Cobh Harbour, is absolutely magnificent and unique. As a Diocese, we have every reason to be proud of our Cathedral and this centenary celebration is an opportunity to give thanks to God for it and ask Him to protect it. The people of Paris are very proud of Notre Dame, so too we are proud of St. Colman's.

Our Lady of Knock Novena August 14th – August 22nd: This year 2019 marks the 140th Anniversary of Our Lady's Apparition at Knock in August 1879. In Knock during the Novena there will be two sessions daily 3pm & 8pm, with guest speakers (see noticeboard for details). Copies of the Novena are available at Church entrances. At about 8 o'clock on the Thursday evening of the 21st of August, 1879, the Blessed Virgin Mary, St. Joseph and St. John the Evangelist appeared at the South gable of the Church at Knock, County Mayo, Ireland.Beside them and a little to the right, was an altar with a cross and the figure of a lamb, around which angels hovered.

There were fifteen official witnesses to the apparition-young and old, who watched it for two hours in pouring rain and recited the Rosary. Two Commissions of Enquiry accepted their testimony as trust-worthy and satisfactory in 1879 and 1936. Today, Knock ranks among the world's major Marian Shrines, having enjoyed the full approval of the Church, for many years. It has received privileges from four Popes and the most recent privileges were the visits of Their Holiness, Saint Pope John Paul II, on September 30, 1979 and Pope Francis August 2018.
