Safeguarding Message from Most Rev William Crean Bishop of Clovne 30th/31st March 2019:

My Dear Friends,

I take this opportunity on Safeguarding Sunday to reflect on some aspects of Safeguarding and recent events in the Church during the past year. I wish to express my gratitude to all the women and men throughout the diocese engaged in Safeguarding Children and vulnerable adults. Due to their dedication and commitment, the Church in Cloyne has put in place, good structures to ensure that children and young people can take part in the life of the Church, in a safe and compassionate way. I am thankful to the Diocesan Safeguarding Committee and all Safeguarding personnel for their engagement to this task. On my visits to Parishes for Confirmation, I have met many Parish Safeguarding Representatives and seen the work they do. They are an inspiration to us all.

Children and young people have a right to see in us adult Christians the true face of Jesus and be able to participate in the life of the Church without fear. Unfortunately for some children throughout the world and in our own country, that has not been the case. Many children and young people experienced abuse and suffer from that experience today.

Pope Francis addressed the issue of abuse in the Church before he came to Ireland in his letter to the People of God and also addressed it at the World Meeting of Families, where he sought forgiveness for the crime and sins of abuse in the Church. At the recent summit of abuse in Rome with Bishops from around the world he said: "If in the Church there should emerge even a single case of abuse – which already in itself represents an atrocity – that case will be faced with the utmost seriousness. Brother and Sisters: in people's justified anger, the Church sees the reflection of the wrath of God, betrayed and insulted by these deceitful consecrated persons. The echo of the silent cry of the little ones who, instead of finding in them fathers and spiritual guides, encountered tormentors, will shake hearts dulled by hypocrisy and by power. It is our duty to pay close heed to this silent, choked crv." (24th Feb 2019). We need to be constantly vigilant in the Church and in society to ensure abuse of children is never tolerated and is dealt with as a crime.

It is my hope and vision that in our Diocese:

- Young people will continue to be able to take part in the life of the Church.
- That all of us continue on the road to ensure that best practice in Safeguarding Standards are upheld.
- And that those who suffered abuse in the Church may find healing and peace. With prayerful good wishes.
