Massacre in Sri Lanka: Sri Lanka is an Island nation in the Indian Ocean with a population of 20 million people, 70.2% is Buddhist, 12.6% is Hindu, 9.7% is Islamic, 7.4% is Christianity. On Easter Sunday morning 2019, 359 people were brutally killed by nine identified suicide bombers, one a pregnant woman. They were Islamist extremists, connected with Isis, claiming to avenge the gun attack in Mosques in New Zealand in March, in which 50 people were killed. In Sri Lanka three Catholic Churches were targeted and three hotels. It was one of the worst terrorist attacks since 9/11. It was well organised and the bombs went off simultaneously. People in the Churches were attending Easter Sunday Mass. It was a pure evil attack on innocent men, women and children. The Government had received warning of possible attacks in previous weeks, but seems to have done nothing to alert the people. It proves true the saying: "There is no surer way for evil to triumph, then for good people to do nothing". In these moments of evil, we Christians turn to the Cross of Christ, even in Easter time, because by His Cross, He has redeemed the world. We ask God, this Mercy Sunday, to have mercy on those who died, so brutally and to comfort the relatives and friends in their extreme grief. We keep all the people of Sri Lanka in our prayers at this time of cruel evil attack. Let us turn to the Merciful Lord today and ask Him to protect humanity and to protect all of us from evil.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION IN KILLALCUIG:Next Sunday, May 5th, the children from Glenahulla National School will receive their 1st Holy Communion at **10.30am Mass (Please note the later time).** The Real Presence of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist is central to our Catholic Christian life.
